NEW RECYCLE PROGRAM: Ingersoll Township, in conjunction with Republic Services, is pleased to announce a new expanded, curbside recycle collection program. Starting January 10th residents will have their first carted curbside recycle collection. Your new 95-gallon recycle cart (light blue lid) will be delivered mid December. The new recycle service will continue to be collected on an every other week basis. Please refer to the 2019 calendar for your recycling schedule. **Your carts should be placed at the curb NO LATER THAN 6:00 AM on your collection day.** Make sure you have placed your carts a minimum distance of four feet from all objects.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION: Bulky items are defined as: Stoves, water tanks, washing machines, furniture, swing sets, patio furniture, chairs, couches, bed springs, water heaters, mattresses, and other large waste materials. Freon bearing appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners and freezers will be collected.

Please **check** your **2018 Winter Tax Bill** to see if your primary residence exemption is correct. If you feel an error has been made, contact **Frank Roenicke** by **December 7, 2018. Property Transfers and Homestead Affidavits must be filed with Frank Roenicke at 8681 Wandering Way, Freeland, MI 48623.** He can be reached @ **989-708-1162** or <u>fjroenicke@gmail.com</u>. Mr. Roenicke will continue to be updating the Township's property records by preforming a review of all real property. The review will consist of an exterior inspection of all structures and a brief interview of the property owner if possible.

<u>BUILDING DEPARTMENT:</u> Need **permit** or **inspection, Midland Township 989-835-8866**. Hours Monday 8 am – 4 pm; Tuesday – Thursday 8 am – 1 pm; closed on Fridays. Farm structures used for farming do not need a building permit but they **do need a zoning permit** before construction is started. All building applications can be downloaded from Ingersoll Township's website.

BURNING PERMITS/FIRE RUNS: All residents in Ingersoll Township 1-866-922-BURN, or by Internet www.michigan.gov/burnpermit. Calling either the above number or by internet only tells you that the conditions are or are not right for burning in Midland County. This call does not relieve the responsible person(s) of liability for all damages resulting from the escape of the fire. State Law states that any open burning, when the ground is not snow covered, requires a burning permit. NOTE: If you are going to burn, we recommend that after calling the number to see if you can burn, Call 911 and give your name, phone number and location where you will be burning so they are aware of your burning. This may eliminate receiving a fire bill from the Township.

<u>ACCIDENTS/FIRE RUNS:</u> Ingersoll Township is billing people involved in accidents in the township for fire runs for these accidents. You should send the bill to your insurance company to see if it is covered. If not you are responsible for this bill.

MIDLAND CITY LANDFILL: 4311 E. Ashman 989-837-6988. Landfill Hours: Monday – Friday 8 am – 4 pm. Saturdays (March -- November) 8:30 am – Noon. Ingersoll Township residents are allowed to take one trailer load (3 cubic yards) into the Midland Landfill FREE each month. More loads from same address will be charged according to disposal rates. Demolition and building materials may be included in the load.
