ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING MATERIALS:

- ✓ Your first recycle collection East of Sasse will be January 2nd and West of Sasse January 8th.
- ✓ Clean plastic bottles & Containers #1, 2, 4, 5, &7
- ✓ Clean food & beverage cans or cartons
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Clean flattened cardboard & paperboard
- ✓ Clear and colored glass bottles

- ✓ You will continue to use the current 95-gallon recycle cart you have. Should you need another, you can purchase one from Priority on our website at www.PriorityWaste.com. All carts cannot exceed 50 pounds in weight.

PRIORITY TIPS AND TRICKS

- ✓ Cart maintenance
 - Use dish soap and garden hose to keep carts clean.
 - Please bag all trash to help control smells and most importantly reduce the blowing of loose garbage when the carts are being serviced.
- ✓ Christmas Tree Disposal
 - Christmas trees will be collected from December 26 through January 31 on your trash collection day.
- ✓ Placement
 - Please allow for a minimum of 3 feet of clearance around your cart.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

- ✓ Your new service day will be on Mondays with the first collection January 2nd.
- ✓ We start collection at 6am until we are finished. The time you are serviced is subject to change week to week. We recommend placing your materials to the curb the night before your collection day.
- ✓ You will continue to use the current 95-gallon trash cart you have. Should you need another, you can purchase one from Priority on our website at www.PriorityWaste.com. All carts cannot exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- ✓ Ingersoll Township residents are allowed one (1) bulky waste/white goods item per week.
- ✓ Items included are fixtures, couches and chairs, mattresses, refrigerators with freon removed, carpet or padding rolled, cut and tied into a four (4) foot section, bathtubs, sinks, and toilets. All doors on appliances must be removed for safety purposes.
- ✓ Excluded items are large amounts of building refuse, bricks, concrete blocks, and large quantities of furnishings and materials resulting from fire, basement flooding, or similar occurrences.
- ✓ Priority will also not collect engines, transmissions, or rear axles, or bulky items resulting from the homeowner's personal repair or remodeling that exceeds 4 feet in length.
- ✓ Any item set out for collection, refuse, recycling, or bulk, that is unacceptable will be tagged and noted as to why it cannot be collected.
